

COVID 19 – club communication no.5 – 24 July 2020

On-Campus Club Events and Activities

Curtin Controlled Venues (including Room Bookings & Curtin Stadium)

On-campus venue bookings can now commence for Semester Two. Further details about club bookings using Curtin controlled spaces are listed below:

- Face to face activities for students will resume for the commencement of semester 2 (3rd August).
- All spaces have had capacities updated to reflect social distancing, this cannot be exceeded.
- Teaching activities will take priority over all other bookings (including club activities); and bookings for teaching weeks will not be confirmed until after teaching has commenced (3rd August).
- All bookings and events are capped at 100-person capacity.
- The Scheduling Office and the Guild encourage everyone to continue to practice good personal hygiene, to stay away from campus if unwell, and to maintain distance between yourselves and others wherever possible.

Please note that due to increased classes being scheduled to account for reduced room capacities, there will be fewer available rooms on campus for non-teaching bookings. You may need to be flexible with your times and be prepared to modify your activities accordingly. We appreciate your understanding with this.
